Guidelines for abstract submissions

General requirements

- Abstracts must be relevant to the themes of the conference
- Oral and poster presentations are welcomed both in French and English. To make sure that your work is accessible to all participants, we encourage French native speakers to provide an English translation of their abstract.
- There is no limit to the number of abstracts that may be submitted by an individual, company, organization, or institution.
- Each abstract should be submitted one time only. Duplicate abstracts will be discounted.
- All participants must register for the Conference and are responsible for their travel and lodging expenses.

Format of submissions

Abstracts should be submitted in Word and must include:

- The title of the proposed paper
- The selected symposium, workshop or panel
- An abstract (300-500 words)
- Keywords
- A short biography (100-150 words)
- Name and affiliation of the author(s)
- Postal address and country of the main author
- Email address of the main author
